Follow these steps to get started copying, playing and recording VHS tapes!



Copy Copy a Tape

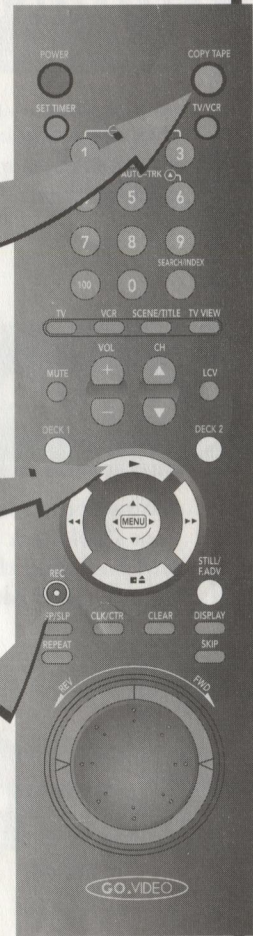
1. Insert Tape in Deck 1
(The one you want to copy!)
2. Insert Tape in Deck 2
(The blank tape!)
3. Press COPY TAPE

Play Play a Tape

1. Insert Tape in Deck 1 or Deck 2
2. Press PLAY
(Most rented movies will play automatically when inserted!)

Record Record a TV Show

1. Insert Tape in Deck 1 or Deck 2
(The tape must have a record safety tab!)
2. Select Channel to Record
(On the VCR! The TV should be set to channel 3!)
3. Press REC

- 1.5V "AA" Batteries (2)

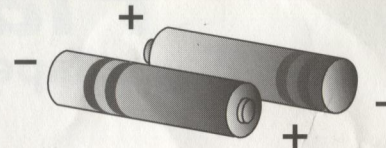


Connections

Follow these steps to set up your Dual-Deck VCR for the first time. See the User's Guide for advanced setup options.

1 Insert Remote Batteries

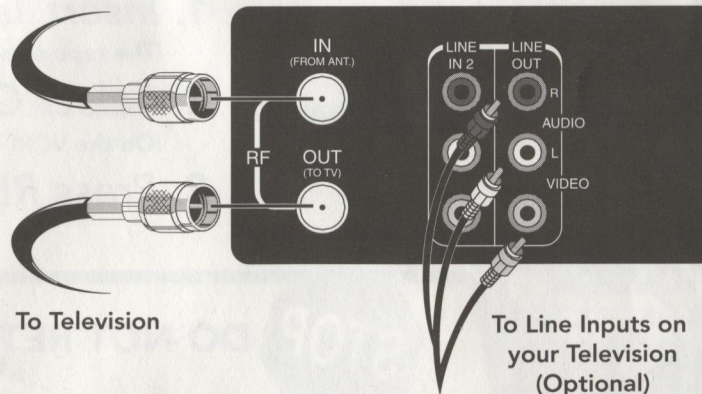
Remove the rear cover and insert the two supplied batteries, paying attention to the correct polarities (+ and -)



2 Connect Dual-Deck VCR

Connect your antenna or CATV cable INTO the Dual-Deck VCR, and connect the supplied RF antenna cable OUT TO your TV.

To Line Inputs on your Television (Optional)

3 Run Auto Setup

Set the CH switch and your TV to the same channel (3 or 4), then follow the easy on-screen instructions to set the language, channels and clock.

POWER
